CTYF VALIDATION GUIDELINES Cost is \$10 per project

- 1. CTYF WILL USE THE TEXAS 4/H AND FFA VALIDATION PROGRAM AS A GUIDELINE FOR ALL SPECIFS.
- 2. CTYF Validation Committee must be present:
 - a. Must consist of at least three members of the following: (one of which must be an Agricultural Science Teacher or Agriculture Extension Agent from Bosque County).
 - i. CTYF Officer
 - ii. CTYF Board Member
 - iii. Agricultural Science Teacher within Bosque County
 - iv. Agriculture Extension Agent within Bosque County
 - b. Each Committee must have one member designated as a Chairman
- 3. Each Exhibitor must sign and fill out:
 - a. Ethics Policy(one for each exhibitor)
 - b. Validation Form for each species
 - c. Hair sample card(one for each animal)
 - i. Parents must be present or **Parental Waiver** (one for each family) if parent is not present their child's advisor is responsible for completing all forms.
 - d. If there is more than one family member per project, all family members' names must be on all forms. (Siblings, step-siblings, or legally adopted may validate the same animal)
- 4. County ear tag must be placed in the center of the **LEFT EAR** with the tag number on the outside of the ear.
- 5. Hair samples for DNA identification will be obtained by collecting 30-40 hairs w/roots and placing them in the appropriate envelope.
- 6. Ear notches (Swine only) should be of adequate depth. Ear notches should be drawn exactly as they appear on the animal's ear and include tears, holes or other identifiable characteristics.
- 7. The County Number (Goats and Lambs only) will be tattooed in the right ear
- 8. Nose Prints (Goats and Lambs only) will be taking, two prints on a single card with the projects ear tag number placed on the card.
