## Central Texas Youth Fair 2024 Scholarship Program for Recent High School Graduate Scholarship and Existing College Student Scholarship

The CTYF will be awarding scholarships in the amounts to be determined after fundraising total is known. The scholarships will be awarded during the Central Texas Youth Fair.

The scholarships will be awarded to students who will be enrolling in college by September 1st of the following school year.

The Existing College Student Scholarship will be awarded only once to a winning applicant.

Each applicant must complete the following steps:

- 2. <u>Three Important Dates:</u>
  - A. May 1, 2024 Application Deadline
  - B. August 28, 2024 Proof of enrollment and Student ID Number for Fall 2024.
  - C. January 15, 2024 Letter of accomplishment from Fall 2024, copy of college transcript from Fall 2024, proof of enrollment and Student ID Number for Spring 2024.
- 3. To be eligible for a scholarship, complete the application form and return by the deadline.
- 4. Payment will be made directly to the college, university, or technical school in two payments. Half of the total amount will be paid for the fall semester, and the second half will be paid for the spring semester upon receipt of the unofficial transcript and letter of accomplishment. You will forfeit the scholarship if letter and transcript are not received by January 15, 2024. The student must remain enrolled for at least one full semester or the first half of the award must be returned to the Central Texas Youth Fair and the second half will not be awarded.
- 5. All scholarship applications are due by May 1, 2024.
- 6. Applications will be reviewed by a panel of judges.
